
# **Packing List**



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### **PACKING FOR TRAVEL**

#### On Your Person



Remove anything from your wallet that's not required for your trip. Pack two credit cards and a quantity of cash (USD/EUR + local currency).

## In Your Carry Bag

Your carry bag may be a Street Satchel or Street Pack.

Pack the following items in this bag and keep the bag with you at all times while in transit:

# Electronics and equipment

Laptop and/or tablet
Camera
Satellite phone (if required)
Satellite messenger (if required)
Headphones
Notebook, pen and pencil

Removable media (USB drives, SD cards)
SIM cards
SIM-eject tool
Spare SD cards
Additional of cash

Pack the Station XV Street Belt in your Street Pack so you have an additional carry option at your destination.

Place an Apple AirTag (or equivalent tracking device) inside your Street Satchel or Street Pack.

## In Your Carry-On Bag

Pack the following items in your Travel Duffel:

#### Power

- Large capacity power bank
- Solar panels (if required)
- Charging cables
- Travel adapters

#### **Documents**

Carry a spare set of travel documents in your Travel Duffel.

- Colour copy of passport photo page
- Air tickets
- Hotel reservations
- Travel insurance
- Additional cash

## Personal items

- Spare glasses or contact lenses
- Sunglasses
- Travel umbrella

- Soap and shampoo
- Toothbrush, toothpaste, dental floss


# Personal first aid kit Different-sized plasters for small cuts Gauze pads (single sterile packs of different sizes) Crepe bandages Antiseptic solution Motion sickness tablets Dimenhydrinate (Dramamine) - will cause drowsiness Meclizine (Bonine) - may cause drowsiness Pain relief Ibuprofen (Advil, Motrin) Naproxen (Aleve) Acetaminophen (Tylenol) Antihistamine tablets and cream Cetirizine (Zyrtec) Loratadine (Claritin) Loperamide (Imodium) Oral rehydration salts Antibiotics for traveller's diarrhoea (e.g., Azithromycin) Anti-malarial prophylaxis (if required)

Pack additional prescription medication in case of delays.

Other prescription medication

Medication for altitude sickness (if required)

#### Clothing



- 2 pairs of pants
- 2 long-sleeve shirts
- 2 t-shirts
- 1 pair of shorts
- 3 pairs of underwear
- 3 pairs of socks
- 1 lightweight waterproof jacket
- 1 lightweight insulated jacket
- Hat
- Gloves

We recommend using one end pocket for toiletries, maintenance and first aid items. Use the other end pocket for power adapters and cables.

Fold up the Station XV Street Tote and pack it at the bottom of the Travel Duffel. That way you'll have some additional carry options at your destination.

Place an Apple AirTag (or equivalent tracking device) inside your Travel Duffel.

#### AT YOUR DESTINATION

Once you've arrived at your destination and have settled into your accommodation, you can reorganise your gear.

Your Travel Duffel will stay in your room. Pack everything you don't need to carry with you into the duffel. Lock your duffel before you leave your accommodation.

Pack any essential items you need to have with you when out and about in your Street Satchel or Street Pack.

You can use the Street Belt to carry essentials under a shirt or jacket.

Ensure you place an Apple AirTag (or equivalent tracking device) inside your Travel Street Satchel or Street Pack.
